ABOULKER, Henri. Clinique et Iconographie Médico-Chirurgicales des maladies de la face et du cou. Paris, A. Maloine et Fils, & Victor Heintz, Alger. [n.d. but 1923.] Presumed first edition having both Paris and Algiers imprint. £585

ALBERTUS MAGNUS & Michael SCOTT. De Secretis Mulierum Libellus, Scholiis Auctus & à mendis repurgatus. [Strasbourg], Lazarus Zetzner. 1607. Placed on the Index with visible evidence of owner censorship via chapter excision, an unsophisticated copy of this famous work, issued only three years after the text had been added to the Index in 1604. £650

ALDINI, Giovanni (Johann). Gemeinnützige, leichtfaßliche belehrungen über schutzmittel gegen die flammen der feuersbrunt, [n.p. possibly Vienna, n.d. ca. 1833.]. Uncommon lithograph reproduction of a pamphlet promoting devices to give 'protection against flames', notably his famous fireproof mask. £685

Attractive, though mixed set of the third (first 1847) and first edition of this charming work on the cultivation of herbs and the establishment and care of a garden. £675

[BIRTH CONTROL.] Small collection of 24 items relating to women's health and birth control, in a variety of formats, published by a number of US and British firms and campaigners, including advertisements, pamphlets, and postcards, issued between the 1930s and 1995. Revealing collection including pamphlets by some of the leading campaigners of the day, and several no doubt printed clandestinely. £585

BONNET, de Beziers. Réfutation du calcul de Pascal sur le problème des chances dans les parties liées; Castelnaudary, G. P. Labadie, 1828. Rare provincial treatise offering an alternative theory and solution to one of the classical problems in probability. £550

[BOOK PRODUCTION.] [BRAHE, Tycho.] [BÖHM, Josef Georg.] Photographische Copie Von Tycho Brahe's Manuscript: "Triangulorum planorum et sphaericorum Praxis Arithmetica etc." [K. k Hofbuchdruckerei v. Gottlieb Haase Soehne in Prag. 1862.] A remarkable publication, one of only five copies produced and we believe the only copy in private hands, of this early attempt at a photographic facsimile. £12,000

Bound Album of technical drawings, plans, and lithograph facsimile course notes relating to rail and bridge building, finely executed in pen and ink, seemingly whilst a student at the École des Ponts et Chaussées taking the 'Cours de Ponts de Croizette Desnoyers 1881-1882'. £985

BURY, Priscilla Susan and Mordecai Cubitt COOKE. Polycystins, Figures of Remarkable Forms &c., in the Barbados Chalk Deposit ... Second edition (though in fact the third) of this rare and visually stunning work on fossil protozoa, an extraordinary fusion of manual illustration, microscopy and photography. £3,200

BUSCH, Dietrich Wilhelm Heinrich. Atlas Geburtshülflicher abbilungen mit bezugnahme auf das Lehrbuch der Geburtskunde. Berlin, August Hirschwald, 1841. First edition of this concise obstetrical manual and lithograph atlas. £685

[CARTOMANCY.] [SWINDELLS, Alice, printer & publisher.] A New and Well-Experienced Card Fortune-Book: Delivered to the World from the Astrologer's Office, in Greenwich Park, for the benefit of Young Men and Blooming Maids; Manchester: A, Swindells, [n.d.ca. 1825?]. Scarce provincial chapbook tapping into the Georgian fascination with cartomancy, a popular pastime amongst fashionable salons of the day. £385

CASTILLON, A. Le Tour du Monde Train Express. Revue Pittoresque et anecdotique de L'Univers. Illustration de M. Pauquet. Paris, Amédée Bédelet, [1862]. First edition of this introduction to geography and ethnography for children. £285

CATOR, Dorothy. In a French Military Hospital. London, Longmans, Green and Co, 1915. First edition (one leaf in facsimile) of this intriguing 'brave and breezy account of the life spent by an Englishwoman nursing in a French military hospital' £50

CAVELL, Edith. In Sacred Memory of Nurse Edith Cavell The Greatest Heroine of the War who was murdered by the brutal hun on August 13th. 1915. Memorial Service at Westminster Abbey May 15 1919. An extremely detailed and extensive illustrated report presenting the conclusions of a survey of the Guadalquivir river between Córdoba and Seville, looking into canal construction. £385

A lovely copy of an extremely scarce, privately published, and expensively produced compendium of British natural history, the work of the Victorian novelist. £2,800

DARLEY, Mrs. The Light of the Morning. The story of C.E.Z.M.S. work in the Kien-Ning prefecture of the Fuh-Kien Province, China. London: Church of England Zenana Missionary Society. 1903. A fervent account. £110

[DECORATIVE ARTS.] Small Collection of 10 Late Victorian 'Crystographs for Glass Decoration', designed to represent Stained glass windows, with examples of borders & centre pieces, [n.p., presumed Fandel, Phillips & Sons, Newgate St., London] [n.d. ca. 1890.] A vibrant and eye-catching collection presumably done in lithograph. £775

Uncommon first edition aimed at a male readership, though disguised as a guide to beauty of the female sex. Containing a series of plates deemed explicit. £775

Perpignan, Mlle Antoinette Tastu, 1858. Rare pamphlet, including five charming lithographs drawn 'from nature' by Mme Onofry, & published by Antoinette Tastu. £685

Rare first edition, second issue of a little-known work discussing the location of the Garden of Eden. £885
- LUYA, Jean-Pierre.** Amusemens Arithmétiques et Algébriques de la campagne. A l'usage des jeunes-gens de l'un & de l'autre sexe. Geneva. DuVillard Fils & Nouffer, 1779. Attractively printed introduction to arithmetic and algebra for children, by a Genovese merchant. £775
- LYELL, Charles and Michael FARADAY.** Report... On the explosion at the Haswell Collieries, and on the means of preventing similar accidents. London: W. Clowes & Sons, 1844. Important pamphlet, by two of the leading scientists of their day, noting for the first time that coal-dust was a major cause of colliery explosions. £775
- MCLAREN, Eva Shaw, (editor).** A History of the Scottish Women's Hospitals. Hodder and Stoughton, London, New York, Toronto. 1919. First edition, and an interesting association copy, of this important historical account, compiled and edited by the younger sister of the founder, Dr. Elsie Inglis (1864-1917). £225
- [MEDICAL SATIRE].** Pair of Rare Nickel(?) and silver 'clyster' buttons/cufflinks depicting the administration of an enema to a patient, inspired by King Louis XIV's obsession with the procedure. [In.p presumably France, n.d. but believed early 18th century, ca. 1715 with later 20th century additions of cufflink]. Vividly satirising the craze for 'lavements' £850
- [MEMOIRS OF A TEACHER.] LAURAS, Adolphe Léon Viviers de.** Attractively compiled and bound manuscript recording the life of the Montpellier teacher Adolphe de Lauras, with additional 'Notes et souvenirs' relating to his daughters, son and grandson. [n.p. possibly Montpellier. ca. 1829 onwards.]. £1,350
- MERY, Jean.** Observations sur la maniere de tailler deans les sexes pour l'extraction de la pierre, pratiquée par Frere Jacques. Nouveau Systeme de la Circulation du sang par le trou ovale dans le foetus humain. Paris, Jean Boudot, 1700. First edition. Whilst ultimately his views were proved to be erroneous, the work is important in the history of circulation. £785

Alzine, [1798-1799.] Rare and typographically appealing introduction for the young républican, an insight into educational works published in the early days of Revolutionary France. £685

[1801-2.] Scarce and attractively bound sammelband of ten practical introductions to the new decimal system comprising three short pamphlets, and seven attractively printed letterpress wallcharts aimed in particular at bakers, butchers, wine dealers, builders, and textile dealers, and all ten publications are extremely rare, almost all missing from the major collections consulted. £2,500

- PEARSON, Emma Maria & Louisa Elisabeth MACLAUGHLIN.** Our adventures during the War of 1870. By two Englishwomen. London: Richard Bentley and Son, 1871. First edition, and a fine association copy, specially bound for Pearson's sister, Harriet Walford-Gosnell, of this account by two of the first British women to serve as nurses for the Red Cross. £550
- [PHILOSOPHY.] [HAVET, Marie Eliza.]** Neatly penned manuscript 'Praefatio in Compendia Philosophia Logie, Moral Physie et Mataphysic'. [In.p. France, signed on p. 145 'Fait par Marie Eliza Havet 1824 le 8 Mai']. An intriguing manuscript of what we presume to be tutorial notes presenting an introductory course on philosophy, logic and metaphysics. £775
- [PHYSICS.] GIRARD, Léon.** Attractively illustrated French student notebook, penned in a single, legible hand. 'Physique' León Girard à Vesoul, 6 Novembre 1863.
