First edition of this uncommon battlefield account by two of the first British women to serve as nurses for the Red Cross, who some believe were romantically involved. **\$520**

ROBERT, Arnault. Atlas Historique Et Statistique De La Révolution. Paris, Chez L'Auteur, Veuve Poussin, 1833. A typographical tour de force, presenting in glorious technicolor an historical and statistical atlas of the French Revolution **\$1,200**

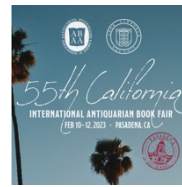
