**[AINSWORTH, James.]** The Imperial Journal of Art, Science, Mechanics and Engineering. Vol. 1. [-Vol. III.] Manchester: James Ainsworth, [n.d. ca. 1840-1845] First edition, all published, of this extensively illustrated and comprehensive scientific periodical, born out of the burgeoning mechanics institute movement. **£1,350**

**[AIR POLLUTION.] TEALE, Thomas Pridgin.** Economy of coal in house fires. or How to convert an ordinary fire-grate into a slow combustion stove at a small cost. London: J. & A. Churchill, 1883. First edition published 'in the hope that it may contribute to the diminution of soot and smoke throughout the Kingdom'. **£200**

**ALDINI, Giovanni (Johann).** Gemeinnützige, leichtfaßliche belehrungen über schutzmittel gegen die flammen der feuersbrunt, [n.p. possibly Vienna, n.d. ca. 1833.]. Uncommon lithograph reproduction of a pamphlet promoting devices to give 'protection against flames', notably his famous fireproof mask. **£685**

**[ALMANAC.]** Jesus! Mit demselben glücklich zu reisen zu Wasser und zu Lande. Leipzig u. Waldenburg, Christ. Gotth. Hofmann, [n.d. ca. 1742]. Popular pocket-sized travel almanac & merchant hand-book. with perpetual calendar with a volvelle **£658**

**[ANATOMY FOR ARTISTS.] MOLLIER, Siegfried.** Plastische Anatomie: Die Konstruktive form des menschlichen körpers. München, J. F. Bergmann. 1924. First Edition, 'a new genre of artistic anatomies' (Röhl p. 278). **£385**

**[ANIMAL MAGNETISM.] DONNE, Alfred.** [Drop-Head Title.] Mademoiselle Pigeaire. Somnambulisme et magnétisme animal, avec figures. [Noyon. Imprimerie de Soulas-Amoudry. 1838.] A less well-known work, discussing the recent high-profile 'Pigeaire affaire', with 2 striking woodcuts of the young clairvoyant reader. **£325**

**[ARITHMETIC.] JOLY, Théophile.** Extensive and attractive manuscript notebook 'Cahier L'arithmétique' appartient a moi, Théophile Joly ... Fait a Lonzacl. 1851. A charming, unsophisticated, and substantial manuscript exercise book. **£1,100**

**[AVIATION.]** Grand Jeu de la Puce "PARIS-NEW-YORK" [n.p.], n.p. France, [n.d. ca. 1930.] A vibrantly coloured game of 'tiddlywinks' celebrating the first East to West Atlantic aeronautic crossing. **£225**

**[AVIATION.] DANRIT, Commandant (pseudonym Emile-Augustin-Cyprien DRIANT).** L'Aviateur du Pacifique Illustrations de G. Dutriac. Paris, Ernest Flammarion, [n.d. but 1909-1910.] First edition. With chilling prescience, the work imagines a major conflict between the US and Japan, culminating in surprise attack - some thirty years before Pearl Harbour. **£300**

**[AVIATION.] DANRIT, Commandant (pseudonym Emile-Augustin-Cyprien DRIANT).** Robinson de L'air Illustrations de G. Dutriac. Paris, Ernest Flammarion, [n.d. but 1907-1908.] First edition, handsomely published, of this romantic adventure story the central theme being a race to the North Pole in a dirigible. **£275**

**BAYAN, Joseph Félix Ferdinand.** Études faites dans la collection de L'École des Mines sur des fossiles nouveaux ou mal connus. [Premier & deuxième fascicules]. Paris, F. Savy, 1870-1873. Little known, attractive and unusually produced study of fossil mollusks, with notes reproduced in facsimile using a form of lithographic printing. **£1,200**

**BLEGNY, Nicolas & Theophile BONET.** Zodiacus Medico-Gallicus, Annus primus [- Quintus]. Genevæ, Leonarid Chouët. 1680-1682-1682-1685-1685. First Latin edition, all published, of this important and early medical periodical. **£3,800**

**[BODONI.] BUSSON-DESCARS, Pierre.** Traité du Nivellement. A Parme. De L'Imprimerie de Bodoni. 1813. Uncommon first edition of this treatise on surveying techniques, one of Bodoni's final publications. **£600**

**[BOTANY.]** Flore des Dames et des Demoiselles. Paris. Marcilly Ainé, Libraire, Rue S. Jacques, 10. [Imprimerie et Fonderie de A. Pinard] [n.d. ca. 1830s.] Appealing educational boxed set, aimed towards a female readership. **£1,850**

**BRAUNE, Wilhelm** Die Oberschenkelvene des menschen in Anatomischer und Klinischer beziehung. Leipzig, verlag von Veit & Comp. 1871. Uncommon first edition of this finely illustrated anatomical treatise on the femoral vein. **£280**

**[CALIFORNIA PICTORIAL LETTER SHEET.]** Miner's Life - Illustrated The Honest Miner's Songs. [Entered According to Act of Congress] by Barber & Baker, in the Clerk's Office of the District Court of the Northern District of California. Published by Barber & Baker, corner of Third and J Street, Sacramento. [n.d. ca. 1854-5.] A somewhat fragile, but scarce surviving example of a gold rush inspired pictorial letter sheet, filled with a lengthy letter home to England from a young prospector, Thomas Cockburn, apparently from Tweedsmouth near Berwick-upon-Tweed in Northumberland. **£1,200**

**CHAM. [pseudonym, Amédée de Noé.]** Cours de Physique Paris, Maison Martinet... n.d. ca. 1861.] Appealing introduction to the principles of physics, through a series of engraved and often humorous. **£285**

**[CHRISTIN, Jean-Joseph?] Exposition Abregée du Nouveau Calendrier Perpétuel. [colophon: [Paris] Le Nouveau Calendrier se vend chez le sieur Tissot, L. F. Delatour. 1772.] Scarce explanatory manual for 'a new perpetual calendar' **£385****

**CONTA, Olga, Mile.** Contribution a L'Étude de Sommeil Hystérique Imprimerie des Thèses de la Faculté de Médecine de Paris, Ollier-Henry. Paris, 1897. Rare French doctoral theses, and interesting association copy bearing the ex-libris of a female

contemporary colleague, Glafira Abricossoff (1860-1940).

**[CREST COLLECTING.]** Late Victorian/Edwardian Album of Arms, Crests, and Monograms, anonymously compiled, containing over 570 late Victorian and early to mid-20th century printed, embossed, and engraved monograms, arms, and crests, including military insignia, University College arms, hotel letterheads, company logos etc, all mounted within purpose printed album published by Cowell's Anastatic Press, Ipswich, [n.d. ca. 1870s- 1920s.] **£225**

**[DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS - INDIA.]** Notes on Building and Road-Making with rules for estimating repairs to tanks and channels: Fifth edition. Madras, 1862. Uncommon later edition, (first 1852?), of this well illustrated manual of civil engineering. All editions appear to be scarce. **£340**

**[DIALLING.] VALLE, Gaudenzio.** Le Panorographe ou L'heure de tous les Pays Priz fixe cent. 50. Tip Novara diretta da Rizzotti e Merati. [Ing. Gaudenzion Valle, Novara, Privativa in Italia E Francia, S.G.D.G.] [n.d. ca. 1885 - 1900s.] A scarce, portable pocket time conversion device, made in Italy for the French market. **£385**

**DU MOLINET, CLAUDE.** Le Cabinet de la Bibliothèque de Sainte-Geneviève. Paris, Antoine Dezallier, 1692. First edition. Important and beautifully illustrated catalogue of the famous 17th century wunderkammer. **£3,800**

**[EDUCATIONAL PICTURE SHEETS.] DESIR, Adeline.** Abécédaire Français. Méthode A. Désir. Premier [- dixième] tableau. Paris, Se vend Chez l'auteur, [n.d. ca. 1873.] A wonderfully striking and scarce set of this didactic French 'ABC'. **£1,350**

**[EDUCATIONAL PICTURE SHEETS.] WACEY, J.** Epitome of Universal History From the Creation to the Peace of 1828, divided into 21 periods. For the Use of Children. [London] Published by J. Wacey, [n.d. ca. 1835?-1837.] A vibrant partial run of this illustrated introduction to world history for children. By their very ephemeral nature, such an extensive run is rare. **£2,750**

**[ELECTRICAL ASSOCIATION FOR WOMEN.]** Six Large Colour Demonstration Wall-Charts. Issued by the Electrical Association for Women, 20, Regent St. London, S.W. 1. ca. 1940s-1950s. Showing the inner electrical workings of common domestic appliances, from the early days of the Electrical Association for Women. **£750**

**[ELECTRICAL ASSOCIATION FOR WOMEN.]** Two Fabric Educational Tea-Towels Issued by the Electrical Association for Women. EAW Publications Ltd. 25 Foubert's Place London, W1V 2AL. ca. late 1970s - early 1980s. Two vibrant and evocative, albeit wonderfully anachronistic, educational visual aids. **£150**

**[ELECTRO-GALVANIC PENDANT.] [MORON, Edouard and Bugéne LEGRAS.]** Médecine Nouvelle Plaques Dynamo-Dermiques Epithème Vitaliste. Brevetées S.G.D.G. Paris, ca. 1890-1900. A scarce medical curiosity **£485**

**[ENEMA CUFFLINKS].** Rare Nickel(?) and silver 'clyster' buttons/cufflinks depicting an enema procedure, inspired by Louis XIV's obsession with 'lavements'. [n.p. but France, n.d. believed ca. 1715 with later 20th century additions]. **£850**

**FÉRÉ, Charles.** Les Épilepsies et les Épileptiques. Paris, Ancienne Librairie Germer Baillière. 1890. First edition, and a presentation copy, of this noted work on epilepsy, including 11 mounted Woodbury types. **£985**

**FIGUIER, Louis.** Connais-Toi, Toi-même notions de physiologie. A l'usage de la jeunesse et des gens du monde. Paris, Librairie Hachette et Cie...1879. First edition of this extensive work on physiology, 'Know Thyself'. **£350**

**[FRENCH REVOLUTION.] [DROP HEAD TITLE.]** Loi Relative à la peine de mort, et au mode d'exécution qui sera suivi à l'avenir. Donnée à Paris, le 25 mars 1792. [Paris, l'Imprimerie Royale 1792.] Law introducing the guillotine **£785**

**[GAME OF GOOSE - HERALDRY.] [SILVESTRE, Charles-François.]** Carte Méthodique pour apprendre aisement le Blason. Paris N. J B de Poilly, [n.d. ca. 1750.] Created for the grandson of Louis XIV, to be played either cut up as playing cards, or retained as a board game with dice: an easy and methodical way to learn the 'heroic science of the coat of arms' **£2,800**

**[GEOMETRICAL MODELLING GAME.]** Il Tredimensionale figure, geometriche piane e solide per disegno matematica, geografia. In 30 posizioni diverse. Socar Reggio. Brevetto no 586574 no. 15. [n.d. ca. 1930s?] A striking and extremely scarce 3D geometrical teaching aid. **£785**

**[GIRL-GUIDING.] BEATON, Audrey Evelyn.** Bound neatly penned manuscript 'Memoirs Of Guide And Brownie [Days]' by PS Audry Evelyn Beaton, 7th Leek Congregational. September 1941 - February 1950', dated on front inside cover 28.9.1952. A charming 'memoir' and keepsake, offering a unique glimpse into the life of a young girl. **£225**

**GOODWIN, M.E. and Olive I MORGAN.** Practical Science Of Living Things, Books I - IV. Illustrations by F. I. Noble, The Gregg Publishing Company Ltd. London, W.C.1 [ca. 1938? - 1951.] Offered together an appealing, though mixed, set of this series of biology text-books aimed at secondary school pupils. **£200**

**GRAND, Dr Jules.** Hygiène Rationnelle, Végétarisme (Causeries du Médecin) (1re Série). Les Editions Théosophiques... [Mayenne, Imprimeries Charles Colin.] 1913. Uncommon work promoting both the physical and spiritual health benefits of vegetarianism by the President of the Société végétarienne de France. **£150**

**[GUIDES TO SEX.] VAN DE VELDE, Theodor Hendrik.** Sex Efficiency through exercises. London, William Heinemann (Medical Books) Ltd. 1933. A remarkable guidebook for women, including twelve flicker-card films. **£550**

**HAUSHALTER, Paul, Louis SPILLMAN et al.** Cliniques Médicales Iconographiques. Paris, Ane Libie Carré et C. Naud. 1901 [-2]. Rare atlas of morbid pathology containing a collection of photographs of clinical cases. **£1,500**

**HOUSSAYE, Arsène.** Les Femmes du Temps Passé Paris, Morizon, 1863. First edition, beautifully bound, of this work celebrating the life of twenty famous 18th century women, with fine engraved portraits. **£450**

**[HYDROTHERAPY]. [ALBANI, Guiseppe, editor].** Regolamento dei Bagni della Porretta. Bologna Tipographia Governativa Cassi, 1827. Scarce printed tariff for the noted thermal baths of Porretta famed for their sulphurous waters. **£200**

**[HYDROTHERAPY.] [AMUSING ENGRAVED BROADSIDE.]** ‘Schoenbrunn Au Docteur Hegglin et aux habitants de Schoenbrunn’. Souvenir d’un retapé. 1880-1885. [n.p., n.d. ca. 1890s-1900]. **£1,250**

**KRAITCHIK, Maurice.** La Mathématique des jeux ou récréations mathématiques. Bruxelles, Stevens Frères, 1930 First edition of this noted collection of mathematical games and puzzles, by the Belgian mathematician. **£185**

**LAUGIER, Ernest.** Mémoire sur la Détermination des Distances Polaires des Étoiles fondamentales. Paris, Typographie de Firmin Didot Frères, fils et Cie. 1859. Including illustrations of a noted meridian instrument. **£285**

**JANSEN Michel and Desiré GUILMART.** Album de L’Exposition 1849. Ameublements Publié par M. Jansen Boulevard, Beaumarchaid No 14 et D. Guilmar, 2, rue de Lancry. Paris, [n.d. but 1850.] A wonderful and rare decorative arts album celebrating the finest furniture makers of the day. **£2,000**

**LÉVY, Albert.** Cent tableaux de science pittoresque Paris, Hachette. 1883. First edition, most attractively produced, popular work of science, copiously illustrated with finely executed steel engravings. **£350**

**[MARITIME REGISTRATION.]** ‘Livret Pour Les Matelots’ n.p. France, [n.d. ca. 1788.] A scarce survivor, a pre-printed personal service record book for a French sailor, no doubt subject to all weathers. **£685**

**[METRIC SYSTEM.] LESLIE, Dr. Glenn F. and Marvin I. GOLD.** Meet the Meters! New York: Ballantine Books. 1976. First edition. Appealing and popular mathematical introduction presented in the form of a cartoon. **£80**

**[MIDWIFERY CASE HISTORIES.] HARRIS, Alice.** Six small oblong volumes of manuscript notes compiled by a registered midwife working in Warwick and surrounding areas. Completed in pre-printed note-books. Spanning the years 1921- 1935. A remarkable, and at times poignant, snapshot of the work of a British midwife during the inter-war period. **£650**

**[MILITARY CUT-OUT COSTUME BOOK.] JOB (Onfroy de Breuille, Jacques Marie Gaston) and Aristide FABRE.** Guerriers et Grands Seigneurs Musée du Costume. Série de Découpages. Texte par Aristide Fabre. Illustrations de Job. Hachette et Cie. [colophon Corbeil. Imprimerie Éd. Créte] [n.p. Paris, n.d. 1904.] Uncommon first edition, unused, one of a series of cut-out costume books illustrated by the noted French artist and children’s illustrator describing and illustrating ‘Warriors and Great Lords’ throughout French history. **£425**

**M’NAB. [MACNAB], Alexander.** Compendium of the Ligaments; Illustrated by woodcuts. London: Published by Henry Renshaw, 1835. Uncommon introduction to the fibrous structures. **£285**

**[NEURO-ANATOMY.] GAVOY, Émile Alexandre.** L’Encéphale Structure et description Iconographique. Du cerveau, du cervelet et du bulbe. Paris, Baillière et Fils. 1886. A notable work of neuro-anatomy with 59 striking life-sized plates. **£650**

**[PAPER TOY.] [BARNUM, P.T. and ‘Tom THUMB’.] [BARNUM, P.T. and ‘Tom THUMB’.]** La Ville De Tom Thumb Le Constructeur de Chateaux de Cartes. [n.p. France, n.d. ca. mid-late 19th c.] Extremely rare and charming architectural toy. **£1,200**

**[PARIS - JARDIN DU ROI.]** Martin Monte À L’arbre Jeu de Société. L. Saussine. [n.d. ca. 1880-1900.] A striking speed race game, though very much of its time, ‘celebrating’ the famous bears of the Paris Jardin du Roi. **£1,100**

**[PATHÉ FILM.] [DIDIÉ, Louis].** Le Film Vierge Pathé. Manuel de Développement et de Tirage. Édite par les Établissements Pathé-Cinema. Paris, 1926. First edition of this important early history of early cinema and film production **£1,800**

**[PHYSIOGNOMY.]** ‘Chiffonnier’ Worker’s Brass Registration Badge, numbered 6086, for ‘A. Vallet, Chiffonnier’, describing his physiognomy in abbreviated code, dated 1855. A remarkable survivor of a ragpicker’s registration badge, engraved with an abbreviated code describing his recognizable features. **£2,000**

**[PLASTIC SURGERY.] ESSER, Johannes Fredericus Samuel.** Colgajos Biológicos de la Cara. Traducción del original Ingles. Editado por el “Instituto Esser de Chirurgie Structiva”, Monaco, 1936. First Spanish edition of this important and graphically illustrated work on facial plastic surgery **£1,800**

**[PRINTING HISTORY.]** Women’s Printing Society, (Limited) 213. Great College Street, Westminster. [London, n.d. but before 1893.] An early trade card for this noted press founded in 1876 by Mrs Emma Paterson (1848-1886). **£125**

**RIZZOLI, Francesco** Descrizione anatomica di una nuova lussazione traumatica dell’avambraccio sull’ omero. Bologna, Tipi Gamberini e Parmeggiani. 1863. Discussing a traumatic dislocation of the humerus, with 4 fine lithographs. **£285**

**ROBINET, Jean Baptiste René.** Considérations philosophiques de la gradation naturelle des formes de l’être, ou les essais de la nature qui apprend à faire l’homme. Paris, Charles Saillant. 1768. First edition, Paris issue, of this interesting proto-evolutionary work, of appeal for the ten curious engraved plates. **£550**

**ROSSI, Gaetan de Catanzaro.** Le Compas de Proportion ou les arpenteurs appelés a l’ordre. Genève, Luc Sestié, 1803. First edition of this rare contribution to the geometrical problem of ‘squaring the circle’ **£1,600**

**[SECRET REMEDIES.]** Arrêté de la Préfecture du Département du Gard, sur l’exécution du Décret impérial du 18 août dernier, concernant les Remèdes secrets. Nîmes, J. B. Guibert, Du 12 Octobre, 1810. A scarce survivor and fine example of this Imperial decree issued to regulate ‘remèdes secrets’ in France, of importance in the history of proprietary remedies. **£685**

**SEIFFER, Dr W.** Spinales Sensibilitätsschema für du segmentdiagnose der rückenmarkskrankheiten. Berlin, August Hirschwald. 1906. Unusual practical neurological aid, a hospital bedside diagnostic chart with detachable sheets **£285**

**SÉRAFON, F[erdinand].** Étude sur les Chemins de Fer les Tramways et les moyens de transport en commun à Paris et à Londres. Paris, Dunod, Éditeur, 1872. Detailed study of London inner city and suburban transport networks. **£425**

**[SURGICAL INSTRUMENTS - SALESMAN’S SAMPLE WALLET]. ANCHOR BRAND.** Stainless Steel Surgeons Needles. Black morocco folding wallet containing sample needles. [n.p, n.d. ca. 1930s]. An appealing, near complete, set. **£300**

**[TANGRAM.] GROSSIN, publisher.** Énigmes Chinoises. Paris, Grossin, 1817. A rare and extremely scarce survivor, the first Tangram publication on the European continent, comprising text, puzzle pieces, and 6 hand-coloured engraved folding plates. **£2,400**

**[THAMES BARRAGE.] [BUNGE, Julius Henri Otto.]** Dam the Thames: A matter of Sanitation, Comfort and Economy. Thames Barrage Association. 1936. Third edition. Advocating the creation of a barrage dam at Woolwich. **£80**

**[TRADE CATALOGUE]. [ROBERT, Edouard].** Biberons, Sterilisateurs, Téterelles, Tétines, Tubes. “Robert Paris-Londres”. [Paris, Etablissements Bachelet. n.d. ca. 1905-10]. Sumptuously illustrated trade catalogue by this famous Parisian maker of equipment for the feeding and care of infants. **£350**

**[TRADE CATALOGUE.]** W. P. Love Coach Builder Commercial Road, Paddock Wood [Kent], [n.p. possibly Tunbridge Wells, n.d. ca. 1880s?] Late Victorian trade catalogue, with 40 chromolithograph illustrations of horse-drawn vehicles **£1,200**

**[TRANSFORMATION FORTUNE-TELLING GAME.]** Der Grösste Zauberer Der Ganzen Welt, Neues wahrsagespiel für Herrn und Damen/ Le plus grand Magicien de l’Univers, Nouveau jeu magique pour les deux sexes/ The Greatest Magician of Universe, New magic game for both/ Il maggiore Magiziano dell’Universo, giuoco nuovo per i due sess/ De grootest Toverer van de hele waareld. **TREW, [OR TREV] Abdias.** Directorium Mathematicum ad cujus ductum et informationem tota mathesis et omnes ejusdem partes, [Aldorf.] Georgi Hagen, [n.d. but 1657.] Uncommon practical compendium of mathematics in relation to a number of different fields including music, mechanics and harmony **£1,800**

**TROMMSDORFF, Johann Bartholomä.** Exposition des Acides, Alkalis, Terres et Métaux, de leurs combinaisons en sels, et de leurs affinités électives, en douze tableaux. Dijon, Frantin, 1802. Lovely large-paper copy of the first French edition of this noted classification of chemical compounds, with 12 attractively printed double-page letterpress synoptic tables. **£1,600**

**WATERSTON, David and Edward BURNET.** The Edinburgh Stereoscopic Atlas Of Anatomy New Edition. Section I [- Section V Lower Limbs]. [Copyright T. C. & E. Jack, Edinburgh] [n.d. ca. 1907.] Pathological Atlas with the original wood and metal viewer. **£600**

**[WOMEN IN SOCIETY.] DIETZ, Catinka de.** Large Oblong bound collection of calling cards compiled by the noted Victorian Concert Pianist, containing over 400 items from friends, colleagues and associates from across European High Society. [n.p.], [n.d. but ca. 1890-1901.]. Including acerbic and often slightly scandalous annotations **£2,200**

**[WOMEN’S RIGHTS – MAGIC LANTERN SLIDES.] [YORK & SON.]** ‘The Suffragettes’ Ruse & How Bobby Peeler Foiled Them’ complete set of ten magic lantern slides, drawn and hand-painted on glass to form a storyboard, images credited on final slide to ‘The Graphic’. [n.p. but London, ascribed to York & Son, before 1907.] An extremely scarce set highlighting the women’s rights movement, albeit from the anti-suffrage perspective, satirising the struggle. **£3,850**

**[WOMEN’S RIGHTS – PRINTED HANDKERCHIEF].** Womens’ Rights “1981” And what came of it. Registered No. 364805. [n.p. but Glasgow] [Carslaw and Henderson]. [n.d. but 1891.] A highly evocative anti-suffrage item. **£2,500**

**[WOMEN’S RIGHTS.] [WOMEN’S SOCIAL AND POLITICAL UNION.]** ‘Angel of Freedom’ Design, White China Cup, Saucer And Small Plate made by H. M. Williamsons of Longton, Staffordshire for the WSPU Exhibition held at the Prince’s Skating Rink at Knightsbridge, May 1909. A lovely trio of WSPU china, bearing the striking motif designed by Sylvia Pankhurst. **£3,200**

**[WRITING MANUAL.] [BICKHAM, George.]** The Young Clerks Assistant; Or Penmanship made easy, instructive and entertaining; being a complete pocket copy-book. London: Richard Ware, [n.d. ca. 1733?].
