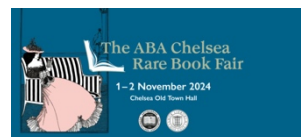

A fine example of this genre of album amicorum, compiled by the son and family members of Queen Victoria's former Chaplain, and including a lock of hair of Princess Charlotte, eldest granddaughter of Queen Victoria and Prince Albert. **£1,400**

- TREW, [OR TREU] Abdias.** Directorium Mathematicum. [n.p. but Altdorf.] Georgi Hagen, [n.d. but 1657.] Uncommon first edition of this practical compendium of mathematics in relation to fields including music and harmony. **£1,800**
- TYPOGRAPHY.] [WELLESLEY, Arthur, Duke of WELLINGTON.]** The Wellington Souvenir - A Golden Record! London: Published by Simpkin & Marshall. 1852. A most attractively produced biography printed entirely in gold, published three days before his State funeral on November 18th. **£500**

London: Published by Day & Son, Lithographers to the Queen. [n.d. ca. 1858-60.] Striking chromolithograph work illustrating examples exhibited at the Art Treasures Exhibition held in Manchester in 1857. **£775**

[n.p. but London, ascribed to York & Son, before 1907.] An extremely scarce set highlighting the women's rights movement, albeit from the anti-suffrage perspective, satirising the struggle. **£3,850**
- [WOMEN'S RIGHTS.] [WOMEN'S SOCIAL AND POLITICAL UNION.]** 'Angel of Freedom' Design, White China Cup, Saucer And Small Plate made by H. M. Williamsons of Longton, Staffordshire for the WSPU Exhibition held at the Prince's Skating Rink at Knightsbridge, May 1909. A lovely trio of WSPU china, bearing the striking motif designed by Sylvia Pankhurst. **£3,200**

- [W.W.I.- NURSING.] [SCOTTISH WOMEN'S HOSPITAL.]** Group of Three Campaign Medals Awarded To Miss A. L. Merrylees, for service during the First World war in Salonika and France, September 1915 - September 1917. **£985**
- [W.W.I.] STOBART, Mrs St Clair.** The Flaming Sword In Serbia And Elsewhere Second edition. Hodder and Stoughton. London, New York, Toronto. 1917. Second edition (first 1916) of this first hand account of the work of the Women's National Service League during WWI, under the courageous leadership of the feminist and medical relief worker. **£85**

[-Vol. III.] Manchester: James Ainsworth, [n.d. ca. 1840-1845] First edition, all published, of this extensively illustrated and comprehensive scientific periodical, born out of the burgeoning mechanics institute movement. **£1,350**
- [ALMANAC.]** L'Art de Plaire. Paris, Janet Libraire, ... de l'Imprimerie de P. Didot ainé. [n.d. but presumed 1812.] [bound with:] Petit Souvenir des Dames, Paris, Janet Libraire ... [n.d. but 1812.] Scarce and attractively bound literary keepsake and almanac for fashionable ladies on the theme of 'the art of pleasing'. **£385**
- [ALMANAC & POCKET LEDGER.] [STATIONARY BINDING.]** Kearsley's Gentleman & Tradesman's Pocket Ledger. For the year 1806. London: G. Kearsley. 1806. Appealing example of an early-19th century personal pocket ledger and memorandum, retaining the original wallet-style binding incorporating front and rear pockets. **£285**

Edinburgh: Gall and English, [n.d. but ca. 1856.] Appealing pocket astronomical guide to the constellations and stars for children, with striking plates printed white on blue mimicking cyanotypes. **£225**

[GAME]. Physogs: The Novel Card Game. Waddy Productions. Patent Applied for Trade Mark. [n.d. but ca. late 1930s - early 1940s]. Rare pseudo-scientific board game with a difference, a popularised version of physiognomy, the art of judging human character from facial features. **£325**

[GAMES & EDUCATION.] The Book of Games; or a history of juvenile sports, practised at a considerable Academy near London. London: Printed for Tabart & Co. 1810. Second edition, in the original pictorial boards, of this scarce illustrated rules and descriptions of twenty-four children's games, introducing the joys of football, cricket, trap-ball (a precursor of baseball), hockey, shuttlecock, leap-frog, marbles, sliding on ice, and even gardening. **£1,800**

JANSEN Michel and Desiré GUILMART. Album de L'Exposition 1849. Ameublemens Publié par M. Jansen Boulevard, Beaumarchaid No 14 et D. Guilnard, 2, rue de Lancry. Paris, [n.d. but 1850.] A wonderful and rare decorative arts album celebrating the finest furniture makers of the day. **£2,000**

[LACE MAKING PATTERN BOOK.] Attractive Manuscript Album Containing Over 200 Patterns And Designs, penned in brown, black, or pink ink, undated but watermarked 'J. Whatman Turkey Mill' 1820 & 1821. Elegantly compiled Regency pattern book, seemingly the work of a single owner, and including designs for Honiton lace. **£4,000**

The Botany of the Malvern Hills, in the counties of Worcester, Hereford, and Gloucester; with the precise stations of the rare plants, London, Tilt and Bogue, [n.d. but 1843.] Presumed first edition of this short work highlighting the wealth of flora to be found in the Malvern Hills. **£75**

Magnificent and lavishly produced account of the important archaeological discovery in 1793 of a luxurious Roman at Woodchester in Gloucestershire. **£8,500**
